
- Must have at least 1-inch straps or illusion straps.

 No V Cut backs or fronts

 No two pieces/midriff showing












< Straps are 1 inch >> V cut on back Front is fine, but back is not.

Miss Peach Blossom Contestants

- Must have at least spaghetti strap, or illusion neckline
- Must be no shorter than mid-thigh, including any thigh slits
 No two pieces/midriff showing
- If the back has a V cut, it must not go further than mid-back (belly button)
- No deep plunging, or strapless necklines. (Halter Dress must have straps connecting in the back, not just wrapped around the neck. Plunging/V necklines cannot go past white dot in photos, if V/Plunge is present there must have a colored mesh panel.)










Miss Peach Blossom Contestants

Must be no shorter than mid-thigh, including any thigh slits
